


CCG IMPROVEMENT & ASSESSMENT FRAMEWORK

Status across domain areas

NHS Bradford Districts CCG

We spend approximately **£1,486** for every person registered with a GP across Bradford (not including the city). This money gives both local doctors and local people more say in how our health care is organised. We buy services for our communities including some of the poorest communities in England and we want to tackle inequalities that contribute to ill health

Self-care

Better self-care: training

10.3% of staff across health and social care have attended training to support people with better self-care

We have the high rate of emergency admissions for urgent care sensitive conditions in England with 3,100 per 100,000 population

3 out of 10 children aged ten or eleven year olds are overweight or obese, this result is the same as the England rate

Better Care

Care quality ratings

Ratings for primary care, hospitals and community services are satisfactory. However, ratings for care homes and residential homes show us there is a great need for improvement in our area

Sustainability

Financial performance Amber

We want to make every pound go further and have developed plans to improve quality whilst saving money. At this time we are not fully delivering planned savings.

Leadership

Quality of Leadership Green Star

In 2016/17 the quality of our leadership was assessed as joint top in England, this top place is shared with 30 other CCGs.

Health inequalities

The frequency of people being admitted to hospital for long term conditions, from our poorest communities is much higher than other areas in England

NHS Constitution Standards

The Waiting time standard for hospital out patient appointments is being achieved. However, for cancer treatment and Accident and Emergency the recommended standards are not being achieved.

Uptake of new e-referrals system

Currently only 1/2 of all referrals are made electronically via the e-referrals services. This needs to be the way all patients are referred by the 1st of October 2018

3 recommended Treatment levels

Attendance for people with a new diagnosis of diabetes is low across England at just 7.3%. Our local result is even lower with just 4 out of every 100 attending

Good control of BP, cholesterol and HbA1c (sugar) is important. However, only 2 out of 5 people with diabetes have good control of all three. This is the same across England

Cancer

Cancer diagnosis at an early stage



Cancer survival at one year

Diagnosing cancer at an early stage is important and only 11 out of 20 cases are diagnosed early. This result is above what is seen across England, however we still need to improve

Almost 3 out of every 4 people with cancer survive beyond the first year. This result is about the same as seen across England

Mental Health

Early Intervention Psychosis



Out of area placements

Access to intervention for psychosis is above the 50% standard, with almost 3 out of every 4 people being seen within 2 weeks for a NICE recommended care package

Reducing out of area placements for people with mental health problems is a key priority – currently there is no data available on the CCG scorecard

Learning Disabilities

Reduce specialist inpatient care



Health checks

For all three CCGs across Bradford district and Craven the rate of specialist inpatients is 47 per 1 million population. We need to reduce this by at least half

3 out of every 5 people aged 14 or over, with a learning disability receive their annual health check, this result is amongst the highest across England

Maternity



Smoking in pregnancy

Recently smoking has increased again with 2 in 10 women reporting as smokers at the time of delivering their baby. This result is above the England rate and needs to reduce

Neonatal mortality and stillbirths

The rate of neonatal mortality and stillbirths has reduced to 7.4 per 1,000 births however there is a national ambition to reduce this to below 0.67 per 1,000

Dementia

Dementia diagnosis



Care planning

4 out of 5 people estimated to have dementia in our population have been found, this result is amongst the best in England

4 out of every 5 people with a diagnosis have care planning and post-diagnostic support in place, again this is amongst the best in England
