The 4th topic will focus on understanding the jargon that is asset based community development, exploring the difference between consulting and engaging with people in your community and why the NHS needs the support of PPGs and GP Practice volunteers to achieve this.

The 5th topic will focus on the role of the PPG and GP Practice volunteers in your community, how to discover and work with other health and care provision and how this improves health outcomes for patients.

The 6th topic will be very practical, helping you to explore how social media can help you to communicate effectively. You will be required to do some pre-work for this session.
