Question) How much money do you have for promotion?

- Answer) We have a lot of money for promotion – but currently stalled at the moment as needing to launch across the system and also waiting on finalising the logo etc.

Question) Where does hard to reach communities fit in this strategy?

- Answer) We work closely with CCGs Comms and Engagement team and use their expertise to ensure that we don't miss out any groups and our local population is involved and people's voice and experience is considered in all aspects of CCGs work.

Question) How will Community Partnerships effect Queensbury

- Answer) Queensbury is part of Community Partnership 8 – so is totally involved.

Question) What's in it for PPGs?

- Answer) Having access to something different and tailored to their needs and requirements e.g. Healthy Eating, smoking etc.

Question) Do you separate practice profile – profiles for each practice – and can we have access to this profile?

- Answer) You are unable to have access to individual practice profiles as its not about individual practice profiles but about community profiles. However, if you require information regarding any practices you can email me and I will send you out the information you require.

Question) Is there any requirements to engage patients – if not why not?

- Answer) We are unable to dictate to Community Partnerships but what we are trying to is to encourage them and inform them that this is good practice – this is new way of working and is more of a hands off model. But I do encourage the CPs to do more for patient representation.
